- 5g. The board needs to consider approving FY18 bills as required.
- 5h. The board needs to consider the disposal method for the old SmartBoards. According to Noah Schaufenbuel, the boards have no monetary value and should be given away or recycled. The first step is to offer them to the staff and then recycle what is left over.

New Business

- 8. The board needs to consider an open enrollment request. This application is for a kindergarten student who wants to attend North Fayette Valley next year. The recommendation is to deny the request based on the district's Diversity Plan.
- 9. The board needs to consider transferring \$5,842 from the general fund to the activity account to pay for safety equipment. Iowa code allows payment of football helmets/facemasks, helmet inspections/reconditioning, tackle rings, shoulder pads, girdles, mouthguards, wrestling headgear and softball catcher's gear.
- 10. The school district currently participates in the Community Eligibility Provision which enables Postville students to receive free meals. The board needs to consider renewing the Community Eligibility Provision for the next four years. The cost to the nutrition fund will be an estimated \$10,350/year or \$41,400 over four years. The recommendation is to continue with the CEP for the next 4 years.
- 11. The board needs to consider the second reading of policy updates.
 - 606.5 Student Field Trips and Excursions. The policy was revised to exclude references for written summaries in the annual report.
 - 401.7 Employee Travel Compensation. I am recommending the meal amounts increase by \$3 for each meal which includes breakfast, lunch and dinner.

12. The board needs to consider the first reading of policy updates.
 - 604.6 Instruction at Post-Secondary Educational Institutions. The policy was revised to reflect the current law. Supplemental weighting can not be applied to Post Secondary Education Opportunities if the school already has a concurrent enrollment course that is the same as the PSEO.
 - 213 Public Participation in Board Meetings. The policy needs to be updated per the needs of the board. Similar policy language will be reflected in board policies: 213.1R1, 402.5 and 502.4.
 - 213.1R1 General Complaints by Citizens
 - 402.5 Public Complaints by Employees
 - 502.4 Students Complaints and Grievances
13. The board needs to consider the Allamakee County Hazard Mitigation Resolution. The resolution approves the district's participation in hazardous mitigation within the county.
15. The board will have a closed session to review a student issue.
